Any necessary discussion of The Beacon

Vehicular access onto Beacon. Members were concerned that a SUV had recently been seen parked on the Upper Beacon, with the occupants apparently having a picnic in the play area. It was suggested that the top gate could be locked, and signage placed on the lower gate excluding vehicular access. However, Members felt this could have been just a one-off incident. Accordingly, it was left for the situation to be monitored, and reviewed in the July meeting.

Grass-cutting around Lower Beacon. C’llr Jackie Prest mentioned issues with inconsistent approaches being taken to cutting of the pathway around the Lower Beacon, with contractors stopping part way round, cutting paths across the middle of the Lower Beacon, etc. Clerk to discuss with Neil McCarthy, and request a site meeting to clarify once again exactly what was required.

Discussion on provision of memorial bench in Middle Street

It was confirmed that the bench had been ordered and paid for, at cost to R.C.C. of £1420. Members agreed to request a contribution from the family of £750-00. Clerk to write a letter accordingly, and send to C’llr Clive Griffith to pass to the family.
